



Dear Traveller

If you are a South African passport holder Expat Explore can lodge your Egypt visa on your behalf.

What we need from you.

1. Two Colour photographs on a white background
2. A Valid passport (at least 6 months from date of return from Egypt) & must have a clean page for visa stamp
3. A completed visa application form (please email info@expatexplore.co.za to obtain this form) Please make sure that it is signed. Leave out any information that you are unsure of (no you don't need to phone us, we will check and complete any unanswered questions)
4. I repeat...make sure the form is signed
5. A copy of your airline ticket (please print a copy for every application)
6. Should the embassy require any additional information from you, please get this to Expat Explore as soon as possible.
7. Please remember that visas issued by the consulate do not necessarily represent a guarantee for admittance into or stay within Egyptian territories. To their sole discretion, Egyptian Immigration authorities reserve the right to deny entry, repatriate, deport or prosecute under Egyptian laws should alien visitors fail at any time to present upon request the necessary documentation or contravene Egyptian immigration laws.

The cost:

We charge R200 per visa application.

Remember:

We cannot guarantee a successful application but we will do everything in our power to get the visa approved.

The process:

Please make sure that your application reaches our office on time. We submit visas on Wednesdays. The visa should be ready for collection by the next Thursday (latest). Should you wish for us to courier your passport back to you, we can do it at an additional R120. We use Berco express who will deliver to your door. Remember to provide us with details for this delivery (physical address and day time phone nr.)
